At River View we want our children to have a rounded understanding of history by the time they leave our school. They need to be able to put historical events into context and order. They need to understand how and why events in the past have shaped the modern world and our place within it, and they need to have had first hand experiences of 'meeting' significant places, objects and artefacts. These experiences can take the form of visits to castles, stately homes or local landmarks trips to museums and galleries or in-school workshops with experts, so that history can come to life for them.
