### Communication and Language - Select an activity from below:

- Play 'Colour I spy' with someone, e.g. "I spy with my little eye something that is blue."
- Go on a 'sound walk' in the day and in the evening. What sounds do you hear on your walk? Tell an adult what you can hear. Remember to talk in full sentences, "I can hear a bus."
- After school each day, tell an adult something that has made you happy or laugh that day. We'd love to hear your responses!

### Maths - Select an activity from below:

- Go on a shape hunt, what shapes can you spot in your environment? This could be when you go for a walk, go to the shop or around your house.
- Match numbers to objects, e.g. If an adult shows you the number 3 - Can you count out 3 pieces of pasta? Can you find three socks?
- Create a repeating pattern, e.g. with colours. (red lego, blue lego, red lego, blue lego).

### Creativity - Select an activity from below:

- Draw a picture of someone who has helped you.

- Build an emergency vehicle using construction materials, e.g. blocks, lego etc.
