## Curriculum Impact

### Impact

In Nursery, the Early Years Foundation Stage Framework is used, covering the seven areas of learning. From Reception to Year 6, Maths is taught using the Maths No Problem scheme of work. Explore tasks are used to introduce a concept, encouraging children to answer in multiple ways.

The implementation of Maths No Problem in September 2022, has resulted in children who now enjoy maths and are excited by the subject. Equally, they are not afraid to take risks with their learning. Children learn collaboratively which has also helped to develop social skills alongside subject-specific skills.
