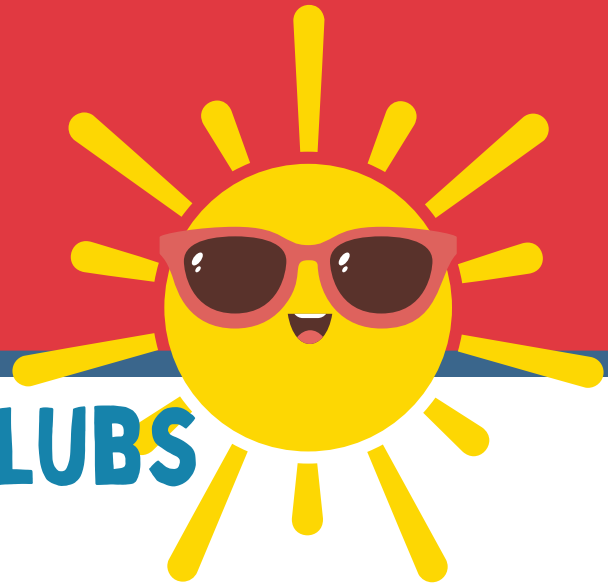

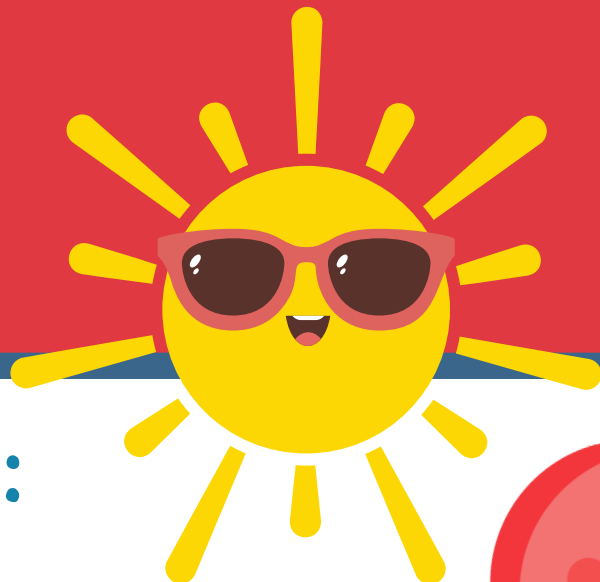
### After-School Dance Club Fun!
