



Good To Be Green

As you may be aware, we follow the Good To Be Green Behaviour System, which helps children to accept responsibility for their behaviour and understand that there are consequences to their actions. This system also gives children the ability to acknowledge and change their behaviour. This year we have evolved our behaviour policy to reflect the needs of our children. If a child receives a red card, they will complete a restorative form, which will get emailed home and they will miss some of the next lunchtime to complete an activity with a member of staff. If a child receives 3 red cards in a half term, parents will be contacted to have a meeting with their child and Mrs Simpson. If a child receives 5 red cards in a half term, parents will be contacted to have a meeting with Mrs Whitehouse and their child. These meetings are designed to see what support we can put in place to help your child to follow our RICHER Values and prevent any further red cards from being received. We believe that this positive partnership between home and school is key to helping all children succeed.



Anti-Bullying Week
